

# Kejriwal warns COVID situation dire as capital records highest ever infections

**NEW DELHI, APRIL 11 /--/** The COVID-19 situation in Delhi is "very serious" with 10,732 cases of infection reported in the last 24 hours, the highest ever since the pandemic began, Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal said today as he issued a stark warning--do not step out of homes unless it is urgent. "The fourth wave is more dangerous than the previous wave. The government is closely monitoring the situation," Kejriwal told a press conference. In just a few weeks, Delhi has gone from near normalcy -- with less than 100 cases reported on a single day on February 16, to an exploding pandemic, a grim reminder that the virus is contributing to extract its toll. Kejriwal said the current fourth wave of the pandemic in the city is "very dangerous" and is spreading at such a rapid rate that it has left many people baffled. "Cases have escalated in a big way in the last 10-15 days. And, in the past 24 hours, the city has recorded 10,732 cases. The situation is very serious. This



is the highest single-day spike in Delhi since the outbreak of coronavirus. The previous highest ever single-day spike in Delhi -- 8,593 cases -- was reported on November 11, 2020. That day, the city had recorded 131 COVID-19 deaths, the highest single-day fatality count till date. The chief minister said that his government does not want to impose lockdown in Delhi but such a situation may arise if there is a rush to the hospitals and beds are unavailable for serious patients. "We

need your cooperation. If your cooperation is received and situation of hospitals is under control, there will be no need to impose lockdown in Delhi. But, if beds in the hospitals fell short and are unavailable, then lockdown may have to be imposed," he said. He said lockdown should be imposed by any government only when its hospital system has collapsed. "I am not in favour of lockdown. I believe lockdown is not a solution to deal with COVID-19. It should be imposed if hospital system collapses," he said. He, however, asked people to remain in home isolation if infected with the virus instead of rushing to hospitals, saying the most important thing is that hospital beds are kept vacant for serious patients.

He said that there was a peculiar contradiction that despite vaccine availability in the country, coronavirus was spreading fast. "As per data available with me, 65 per cent COVID-19 patients are below 45 years. How will coronavirus stop

when 65 per cent of affected are below 45 years for whom there is no vaccination," he said. Kejriwal said that in a recent meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi 2-3 chief ministers requested restrictions on vaccination to be lifted. "Our government is ready to vaccinate people door to door: The time is to launch vaccination at a war footing lifting restrictions of age and setting up vaccination centres." He said that experts say that despite receiving vaccine, people may get infected with COVID-19 but they will not be seriously ill.

So, people need to wear masks and observe all the precautions even after getting vaccinated, he said. Kejriwal asked all political parties to work together to fight coronavirus spread, saying it was not time to do politics and point fingers. He also appealed the religious and social organisations and NGOs to contribute in the fight against the virus and check its spread. (PTI)

## Ambani security scare: NIA arrests Waze's associate Riyaz Kazi



**MUMBAI, APRIL 11 /--/** The NIA today arrested police officer Riyaz Kazi, an associate of suspended cop Sachin Waze, in connection with the case of an explosives-laden SUV found near industrialist Mukesh Ambani's residence, a police official said. Assistant police inspector (API) Kazi was called for questioning again by the National Investigation Agency (NIA) on Sunday and later placed under arrest, he said. He was previously also questioned multiple times by the NIA in connection with the case of the SUV with explosives found near Ambani's residence in south Mumbai on February 25 and the subsequent death of Thane businessman Mansukh Hiran.

After his arrest on Sunday, Kazi was produced before a holiday court here which remanded him in the NIA's custody till April 16 for further probe into the case. Kazi was shunted out of the Mumbai Crime Branch last month, the official said. Earlier, in a CCTV footage, Kazi was seen entering a number plates shop in suburban Vikhroli and having a conversation with the outlet's owner. He was also seen taking away a digital video recorder and a computer of the shop. Kazi was also seen collecting CCTV footage from Waze's housing complex in neighbouring Thane, the official said. The probe agency suspects that Kazi assisted Waze in obtaining fake number plates used for the SUV found with explosives near Ambani's residence in south Mumbai, he said. Hiran, who was in possession of the SUV, was found dead in a creek in Thane on March 5. The NIA arrested Waze on March 13 in connection with its probe into the case. The probe agency had also arrested former policeman Vinayak Shinde and cricket bookie Naresh Gor. All the three are currently in judicial custody. (PTI)

## Pvt hospitals in Punjab asked to defer elective surgeries in wake of rising COVID cases

**CHANDIGARH, APRIL 10 /--/** Amid rising COVID-19 cases, the Punjab Health Department on Saturday asked private hospitals to defer elective surgeries till April 30 to meet increasing demand for beds. In a virtual meeting with representatives of private hospitals, Punjab Principal Secretary Health and Family Welfare Hussan Lal also directed them to charge government-fixed rates for the treatment of coronavirus patients. There are 213 private hospitals on board for COVID-19 treatment in the state at present and the government has provided 230 ventilators to these hospitals which should be used optimally, he stated. The principal secretary expressed concern about the rising number of fatalities, especially while shifting the patients from level-2 to level-3 facilities and advised that referral should be made in time, according to an official statement. Lal said more than 20,000 doses of antiviral drug Remdesivir have been provided to the government and private hospitals. He urged private hospitals to set up COVID vaccination centres.

The principal secretary reiterated that oxygen demand and supply must be communicated to the civil surgeon of the district so that in case of any additional requirement, it could be made available from the appropriate source well in time. Meanwhile, Punjab Health Minister Balbir Singh Sidhu said the health department is conducting a massive vaccination drive at more than 2,500 centres in Punjab. Sidhu said the Centre will send fresh batches of four lakh doses by Sunday after Punjab Chief Minister Amarinder Singh informed it about the shortage of vaccine. (PTI)

## Active COVID cases shoot past 20,000 mark after 5 months

**AMARAVATI, APRIL 11 /--/** The number of active coronavirus cases shot past the 20,000 mark to 20,954 after precisely five months as 3,495 fresh positives were reported, another high after October 24, in Andhra Pradesh today. The state also recorded 1,198 recoveries and nine more COVID-19 deaths in 24 hours ending 9 am today, a health department bulletin said. The overall infection positivity rate climbed to six per cent after 1.54 crore sample tests turned out 9,25,401 total positives so far. The total recoveries increased to 8,97,147 and toll to 7,300, the bulletin said. Chittoor district once again topped the chart with 719 fresh cases in a day with Guntur coming behind with 501, crossing a gross of 82,000 cases so far. SPS Nellore district went past the 65,000 mark, adding 190 cases anew, Kurnool crossed 63,000 with the addition of 191 and Srikakulam shot past 48,000, reporting 293 new cases in a day. (PTI)

## Chopper crash lands in Kerala

**KOCHI, APRIL 11 /--/** A helicopter carrying prominent NRI businessman M A Yusuff Ali, his wife and four others crash-landed at a marshy land near here today morning, police said. All passengers including Yusuff Ali, who is Chairman of international retail group Lulu Group, his wife and two other passengers along with two pilots on board the chopper owned by the company have been admitted to a private hospital here. "All of them are safe. They are currently under observation," a top official of the Lakeshore hospital where they are treated told news agency PT I. The incident occurred at Panangad area at around 9 AM on Sunday, according to a statement issued by Lulu Group International. "Yusuff Ali, currently in Kerala, was on a short trip from his home in Kochi to visit a relative at nearby hospital.

Due to the sudden deterioration of weather conditions and heavy rains, the experienced pilots decided to make precautionary landing at a safe place to prevent any risk to the life of the passengers or public at large," the statement said. "All passengers and crew underwent necessary medical checkup and are safe," it said. An eyewitness said a major accident was averted as the pilots managed to make safe landing in a marshy land near the NH Bypass at Panangad.

Besides the busy highway in the neighbourhood, the small plot of land with compound walls is surrounded by electric lines and buildings. The incident occurred as the helicopter was slated to land on the ground of the Fisheries College, Panangad.

The distance between the ground and marshy land is about 200 metres, they

said. A local person said he rushed to the spot seeing the chopper at the marshy land. He, along with the pilot of the chopper, took Yusuff Ali to safety. "It was raining heavily. He was provided a chair to sit. He complained of backpain. The police reached the spot after 10 minutes and took all the passengers to the hospital," the man told a news channel. According to sources, the Lulu Group bought the seven seater helicopter from a famous European manufacturer two years ago. Yusuff Ali's Abu Dhabi-based Lulu Group that owns Lulu Hypermarkets and shopping malls is one of the top retailers in the Middle East and North African region (MENA). It has more than 200 Hypermarkets and Supermarkets in Gulf countries, Egypt, Indonesia, Malaysia, India and employs over 58,000 people from various countries and has logistics centres in the US, the UK, Spain, South Africa, the Philippines, Thailand etc. Last week, Yusuff Ali was honoured with Abu Dhabi's top civilian award. The prestigious Abu Dhabi Award was given to the NRI businessman for his Outstanding Contribution to Abu Dhabi's Business, Industry and support to various philanthropic initiatives. Yusuff Ali who was recently ranked in the Forbes Billionaire list 2021 as the richest Indian in the Middle East also is billed as the most influential Indian in the Middle East thanks to his close proximity with the gulf rulers. He has also received numerous awards, including the Pravasi Bharatiya Samman in 2005, the Padma Shri in 2008, the Order of the King of Bahrain in 2014, and British Queen's Award in 2017. In addition, he is also the first expatriate to get a permanent residency visa from UAE and Saudi Arabia. (PTI)

## UP panchayat polls: BJP withdraws candidature of Kuldeep Singh Sengar's wife

**LUCKNOW, APRIL 11 /--/** The BJP today withdrew the candidature of former MLA and Unnao rape convict Kuldeep Singh Sengar's wife from the Uttar Pradesh panchayat polls. The BJP had made Sangeeta Sengar a candidate for the district panchayat member from Ward No. 22 of Fatehpur Chaurasi, according to a list released by it earlier. "The candidature of Sangeeta Sengar, the wife of former BJP MLA Kuldeep Singh Sengar, who is a convict in the 2018 Unnao rape case, has been cancelled," State BJP chief Swatantra Dev Singh told news agency PTI. Singh said the Unnao party president has now been asked to submit three fresh names for finalising a

candidate. He, however, exuded confidence that the BJP will emerge victorious in the four-phase panchayat elections, beginning April 15. Unnao will go to the polls on April 26. Kuldeep Sengar was awarded life sentence by a Delhi court on December 20, 2019 for raping a 17-year-old girl in Unnao.

After his conviction, Sengar's membership as an MLA was cancelled. Sangeeta had earlier held the post of the district panchayat chairperson. Earlier, BJP spokesperson Harishchandra Shrivastava had said names of all candidates were recommended by the district unit and were forwarded to the party headquarters through the regional unit. ## Over 200 Delhi jail inmates vaccinated against COVID-19 so far, no adverse events

**NEW DELHI, APRIL 11 /--/** Around 200 eligible inmates of the three jails in the national capital have been vaccinated against the novel coronavirus so far, and none of them has reported any adverse events, officials said today. A total of 326 inmates in the Delhi's prisons are above 60 years, and over 300 in the 45-59 age bracket with comorbidities. These two categories are eligible for vaccination in the ongoing nationwide drive. Earlier, the Delhi Prisons Department had set up a COVID-19 vaccination centre inside Tihar Jail to vaccinate the inmates. It was set up in the central jail hospital at jail number 3, they said.

Director General (Prisons) Sandeep Goel said, "Around 160 inmates in Tihar jail and around 40 in Rohini and Mandoli jails have been vaccinated so far." The vaccination drive for prison inmates started on March 18. The officials said they

are sending inmates of Rohini and Mandoli jails to the nearest government vaccination centre under police protection for taking jabs.

According to a senior jail official, the family members of eligible inmates were asked to send the required documents through WhatsApp to jail officer's mobile number for the vaccination process. "We spoke to the families of the inmates asked them to send the documents required for the registration through WhatsApp and then vaccinated them," a senior jail official said. None of the inmates who has received the job reported any complications, the official said. On March 1, the second phase of the COVID-19 vaccination drive began in the national capital. In the first phase, starting January 16, over 3.6 lakh beneficiaries comprising healthcare workers and frontline workers, were vaccinated in Delhi. (PTI)

## Hospitals to get 80 per cent of oxygen produced in Chhattisgarh: Govt

**RAIPUR, APRIL 11 /--/** Eighty per cent of the total oxygen produced in Chhattisgarh will be supplied for medical purposes to hospitals in the state in view of a sudden spike in COVID-19 cases, a government official said today. The state health department on Sunday issued a notification in this regard under the Epidemic Diseases Act on the directives of Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel, he said. As per the notification, manufacturers have been

directed to supply 80 per cent of the total oxygen produced in their units to hospitals as 'medical oxygen'. In case of an urgent requirement, the remaining 20 per cent of the oxygen produced will also be supplied to hospitals, the public relations official said. Manufacturers have also been asked to ensure uninterrupted production of oxygen in their units with their full capacity, he said. Divisional commissioners and collectors have been asked to ensure proper

implementation of the order, he added. On Saturday, Chhattisgarh recorded 14,098 new cases of coronavirus, the highest single-day spike since the outbreak of the infection in March last year, according to the state health department. The state has so far reported a total of 4,32,776 COVID-19 cases and 4,777 deaths due to the disease. As of now, there are 85,860 active COVID-19 cases in the state, while 3,42,139 patients have recovered, as per official figures. (PTI)

## Cancel CBSE board exams: Priyanka to education minister Pokhriyal

**NEW DELHI, APRIL 11 /--/** Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi Vadra wrote to Education Minister Ramesh Pokhriyal Nishank on Sunday seeking cancellation of the CBSE Board exams, saying it will be impossible to ensure safety of students at crowded exam centres. In her letter to the minister, she said by forcing children to sit for these exams during a raging pandemic, the Government and the CBSE board will be held responsible if any exam centre becomes a hotspot with a large number of children becoming infected with the disease. "The Government and the CBSE board might want to consider whether they are prepared to own the legal liability for students or others who might be severely affected by the disease in this manner," she said. She said with over one lakh cases of COVID-19 being reported across the country, lakhs of children and parents have expressed fear and apprehension about assembling at exam centres to sit for the exams in the middle of the second wave of COVID-19.

Vadra said the apprehensions of students are well founded, as giving exams under the spectre of a deadly disease will cause unnecessary anxiety to children and

impact their ability to perform as well. "They are rightfully requesting that the exams be cancelled under the prevailing circumstances. "I do hope that the Government will engage in a dialogue with schools, students and their parents so that a safer way for them to fulfil their educational obligations can be found. Rather than forcing them into a potentially dangerous situation, it would be in the fitness of things for them to be given the support, encouragement and protection that is due to them at this very trying time," Vadra said in her letter. She also pointed out that it is our responsibility as political leaders to protect and guide the young.

As state after state issues guidelines preventing the assembly of large numbers of people in public places, what moral grounds can we stand on, while forcing young children to do exactly that, she asked.

According to the revised date sheet for CBSE board exams 2021, the Class 10 exams would be held between May 4 and June 7 and those for Class 12 would be held between May 4 and June 15. CBSE officials have said that exam centres across the country have been increased by 40-50 per cent to ensure social distancing among students. (PTI)
